- 1. They should live in the school district so there is bus transportation
- 2. Prefer that the family has children in the school district but not necessarily in the same grade but that does not hurt.
- 3. Use school contacts if you have any teachers, counselors, volunteers, School Board, etc.
- 4. Any of your family qualify
- 5. Friends and neighbors
- 6. People from work
- 7. Organizations you belong to
- 8. People from Church; talk to the Minister, Priest, office workers, those involved in education that know the families
- 9. Do your kids know of any one
- 10. Can you send an email blast to people in your email address list
- 11. Interact and Rotaract students
- 12. Past Host Families
