General AI assistants (including writing tasks)

ChatGPT (<https://chatgpt.com>)

- Developed by Open AI
- Includes generation of images and video
- Pricing
 - Free: free tier with basic features and limited access
 - Go: \$8/month
 - Plus: \$20/month
 - Other higher-level individual plans
 - Open AI for Non Profits (ChatGPT Business) at 20% discount

Grok (<https://grok.com>)

- Developed by xAI
- Includes generation of images and video
- Pricing
 - Free: free tier with basic features and limited access
 - Super Grok: \$30/month or \$300/year
 - Other higher-level individual plans

Gemini (<https://gemini.google.com/>)

- Developed by Google
- Includes generation of images and video
- Pricing
 - Free: free tier with google account with basic features and limited access
 - Google AI Plus: \$7.99/month
 - Google AI Pro: \$19.99/month

Claude (<https://claudi.ai>)

- Developed by Anthropic
- Does not include generation of images or videos
- Pricing
 - Free: free tier with basic features and limited access
 - Pro Plan: \$17/month
 - Other higher-level individual plans

Perplexity (<https://www.perplexity.ai>)

- Initially created by a private software company as an internet search engine)
- Access to AI platforms/models such as open AI, Anthropic)
- Pricing
 - Standard: free tier with basic features
 - Pro Plan: \$20/month
 - Other higher-level individual and group plans
 - Enterprise Pro Plan at reduced cost for non-profits

Focused AI writing assistants (platforms with AI support that is more specific to writing, with a focus on improving writing through grammar and spell checking, style adjustments, etc...but some applications for project management and analysis)

All have free tiers with basic features and paid plans with more access and more advanced features

Copilot (<https://copilot.microsoft.com>)

- Generative AI chatbot developed by Microsoft
- Based on Open AI
- Fully integrated with Microsoft 365 (components such as Word, Outlook, PowerPoint)

Grammarly (<https://www.grammarly.com>)

- Self-described as an AI agent rather than a generative AI chatbot, with agentic awareness of the writer's goals and context, enabling predictions of feedback and reactions to the user's writings

Jasper (<https://www.jasper.ai>)

- Self-described as a generative AI-powered writing assistant and content creation platform that utilizes machine learning

AI for note taking

Otter Ai (<https://otter.ai>)

- AI powered note taking/transcription tool that converts speech into text real time, generating transcripts and summaries
- Facilitates speaker identification, includes features such as live chat within the tool to address questions and search within transcripts and summaries; also generates action items
- User can enable meeting bot to automatically join meeting platforms such as Zoom, Teams, Google Meet
- Pricing
 - Free tier: basic features and limited monthly transcription minutes
 - Pro plan: \$8.33/month, with more advanced features and substantially higher transcription minutes, can record meetings up to 90 minutes duration

Letterly (<https://letterly.app>)

- AI powered transcription tool that converts speech into text; also supports content generation
- Emphasis is on shorter meetings
- Pricing
 - No free tier
 - Flat pricing of \$9/month

Fireflies (<https://fireflies.ai>)

- AI powered note taking/transcription tool that converts speech into text
- Facilitates speaker identification, includes ability to search within transcripts and summaries; also generates action items
- Automatic recording of Zoom, Teams, Google Meet calls is supported
- Pricing

- Free tier: supports unlimited transcription but has limits on AI summaries
- Pro plan: \$10/month unlimited transcription and unlimited AI summaries, other advanced features

Fellow (<https://fellow.ai>)

- AI powered note taking/transcription tool that converts speech into text
- Facilitates speaker identification, includes ability to search within transcripts and summaries; also generates action items
- Automatic recording of Zoom, Teams, Google Meet calls is supported
- Emphasizes privacy features and enables users to upload a formatted meeting agenda before the meeting begins, to support structured meeting minutes
- Pricing
 - Free tier: has very restrictive limits on transcription and summarization
 - Team plan: \$7/month unlimited transcription and unlimited AI summaries, other advanced features

AI for design tasks

Free tiers with basic features and paid plans with more access and more advanced features

- Self-described as a visual suite with components powered by generative AI for graphic design

Microsoft Designer (<https://designer.microsoft.com>)

- Self-described as a generative AI powered design tool
- Fully integrated with Microsoft 365 (components such as Word, Outlook, PowerPoint)
