Plastic:

Any plastic (Styrofoam, plastic bags & wrap, any plastic) will be accepted at CRDC at 390 Eberts Lane. (turn right off of the third block on E. Philadelphia St.) **Cost \$2.00/bag**

It should be in a trash bag (preferably their green one or a clear plastic bag) There can be NO metal (no metal twisty tie or a cap or liner that's metal backed)

Best to keep your clear bottles and milk cartons (only) in your neighborhood recycling bin.

Plastic grocery bags (you mean haven't already switched to a reusable canvas bag?) can return to most supermarkets

Glass:

Neighborhood recycling bin – bottles/jars only

No broken glass; no mirror glass or glass panes

Aluminum/Bi-metal cans:

Neighborhood recycling bin

Paper/Corrugated/Cardboard

CPG (Continental Paper Grading) – 3350 Concord Road (down in the industrial complex just of Mt. Zion Rt.24 near post office and prison)

They will accept any paper. Separate bins for paper (magazines, window envelopes, etc.), books (hard or soft cover) and cardboard and corrugated (they will sort between the two).

Metal:

Any metal from wire, to outdoor grills to stoves, etc. You can even get paid for it. Doesn't have to be pure.

CSR – 530 Vander Ave. (just off east College Ave.)

Paz Metals – 4315 Run Way (east York off Market St. past Sheetz , McDonalds, Stonewood Rd. intersection)

At this time No Electronics

Electronics:

TV's, computer monitors, microwave, cell phones, appliances

York County Solid Waste Authority Electronics Recycling - 2700 Black Bridge Rd. (off Toronita St. which intersects with Rt. 30 at Round the Clock Diner)

Open Monday through Saturday – 8 am to 4 pm

No refrigerators, freezers or air conditioning units

Battery Warehouse will recycle.

Apple Stores will pay for your i pad or i phone. Considerable amt. for Mac. Computers

Building Supplies, Tools, etc.:

Re-Source York – 161 E. 9th Ave. Tues. – Sat. 9 am to 5 pm (4 pm Sat.)
Habitat for Humanity – (Harrisburg & Lancaster)

Mattresses:

Unsoiled mattress will be picked up when you buy new

Furniture & Clothing:

Community Aid – 2001 Springwood Rd. (old Mailman's bldg. in shopping center off S. Queen St.)
Pretty liberal about
Salvation Army Donation Center – 1000 Haines Rd.
Clothing definitely, but can be picky about furniture and other stuff.
Goodwill – 981 Loucks Road & 1120 Roosevelt Ave.
Re-Source York (furniture & Appliances)

Lg. Appliances; Refrigerators, Freezers, Air Conditioners:

Will be picked up when you buy new
Resource York will accept if they still work.

Batteries:

Auto: Battery Warehouse, 1519 Mt. Rose Ave., York; they will collect to be properly disposed of
Advance Auto Parts Stores will give you a \$10.00 gift card

Lithium Ion Batteries (rechargeable): Call2Recycle at Home Depot; 2905 E. Market St.
Also, Lowe's, Batteries Plus and Staples

Alkaline Batteries: Any Staples store (only one in York is: Rt. 30/965 Loucks Rd.)
www.staples.com/stores/recycling. They take print cartridges too.

Tires: Penn Tire Exchange; 1090 Roosevelt Ave., York & 3062 S. Queen St.

Will buy the tire if resaleable; Charge \$6.00 to \$8.00 if scrap / more if still on rim. They ship to Emmanuel Tire in Baltimore and Philadelphia. They shred the tires and the product is then used in a variety of products such as mixed with asphalt, arena & playground, septic system field, etc. Monro Auto Service will also take tires and they go to S&J Recycling, also in Baltimore. Many other tire retailers will take, and all will take when you buy new tires.

Used Motor Oil:

Many oil change places, but must be unpolluted – no water or antifreeze, etc. in it. Some have heating systems in the garage that burn used oil.
East York Auto Body – off East Prospect Rd.

Gasoline, Turpentine, Thinner, etc.

Paint:

Re-Source York - must be at least ½ gallon, no rust on the can and not frozen
