

## Guidelines for selecting a student to attend RYLA

The following guidelines are to be used to select the student(s) for the Rotary Youth Leadership Conference. The student(s) should meet the guidelines listed below to ensure a successful RYLA experience.

Remind students that they are expected to enthusiastically participate in all activities, attend the entire conference from registration through the banquet and attend with an open mind.

- 1. The student must be entering their senior year in high school and cannot attend the conference two years in a row.
- 2. The student shall demonstrate academic excellence within the school.
  - o A grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- 3. The student shall demonstrate leadership/participation within the school. (i.e...)

  - Editor in chief of School Yearbook
  - Editor of School Newspaper
  - Captain or co-captain of any sport's team
  - Officer of any musical group
  - Officer of any club or school organization
